Any member of SFI, who affiliates with Starfleet Medical may participate in these training programs.

### **SFMD Certification Program**

The SFMD Certification program consists of the completion of one (1) subject to qualify you for your Starfleet Medical Doctor (SFMD) postnominals.

Requirement: Completion of MDPR101 Introduction to Human Medicine

How to apply: Send your MDPR101 certificate to [sfmedical.training@gmail.com](mailto:sfmedical.training@gmail.com) with the subject topic "SFMD Certification".

You will receive a SFMD Certification certificate and will be entitled to use the postnominals SFMD after your name for all STARFLEET International business. e.g., LT John Citizen SFMD

After you complete your SFMD certification, you may want to explore our CORE Medical Training program.

### **CORE Medical Training Program**

This program consists of ten (10) training levels, with each core level consisting of ten (10) courses, giving a total of 100 courses to be completed.

The levels must be completed in order, commencing with level one (1), and certification in each level is available by submitting a completed medical training record application (see Appendix B).

While these core levels have all been named, no inference should be taken that a member wishing to serve STARFLEET Medical in any role needs to complete the courses at the level that shares their title or that by completing a level confers any related position or rank.

The courses that comprise the CORE Medical training levels are detailed in the following pages, and the process for submitting records for certification is detailed in Appendix C.

## **SPECIALIST Medical Training Program**

This program focuses on several areas of specialist medical knowledge and consist of ten (10) courses for each specialty.

Graduation from the CORE Medical training program is a prerequisite before any specialty studies can be commenced and certification in each specialty is available by submitting a completed medical training record application (see Appendix B).

The courses that comprise each SPECIALIST training area are detailed in the following pages, and the process for submitting records for certification is detailed in Appendix C.

That means that you need to wait for the Director of that College to enter your grades into the SFI database (<https://db.sfi.org/index.php>) before you are allowed to submit another five (5) courses. This is to ensure that Starfleet Academy Directors are not overwhelmed.



Once you complete each level/specialty, the MTRA should be sent via email to [sfmedical.training@gmail.com](mailto:sfmedical.training@gmail.com)

The MTRA MUST be accompanied by either of the following:

1. Screenshot(s) from the SFI database or Starfleet Academy course page confirming the exams required have been passed.
2. Copies of certificates/emails from course directors **for exams not yet entered onto the database.**

Without accompanying evidence of course completion, certification cannot be completed and a certificate cannot be issued.

Once verification and certification are complete, a certificate of completion will be sent to the applicant and an announcement will also be posted on the STARFLEET Medical Facebook Group.

A record of the certification will be maintained centrally by STARFLEET Medical Operations staff.
