Category I: Occupation Awards

These awards recognise outstanding personnel who make a contribution in their own communities that reflect the ideals and goals of STARFLEET Medical.



Medical Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical is a current or retired medical professional.

(Would include [but not exclusively] Doctors, Surgeons, Dentists, Psychiatrists, Veterinarians, etc.)

(Evidence of qualification needed at time of application). **Issuing Authority:** The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



EMT / Paramedic Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who is a current or retired EMT/Paramedic professional.

(Evidence of qualification needed at time of application). **Issuing Authority:** The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Nursing Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who is a current or retired Nursing professional.

(Evidence of qualification needed at time of application).

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Ancillary Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who is a current or retired ancillary professional in the healthcare field.

(Would include [but not exclusively] Homeopaths, Acupuncturists, Control room staff, dispatchers, admin officers, health inspectors, etc.)

(Evidence of qualification needed at time of application).

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Allied Health Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who is a current or retired Allied Health professional.

(Would include [but not exclusively] Audiologists, Nutritionists, Chiropractors, Counsellors, Psychotherapists, Dieticians, Psychologists, Physiotherapists, Occupational therapists, Optometrists, Podiatrists, Osteopaths, Pharmacists, Social Workers, Speech Pathologists, etc.)

(Evidence of qualification needed at time of application).

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Carer Star

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who is a current or retired professional or non-professional personal carer.

(Would include [but not exclusively] aged care workers, childcare workers, carers supporting friends or family members through an illness, specific health challenges, special needs, etc.)

A basic statement detailing the care activities performed needed at time of application.

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations

Category II: Training Awards

These awards recognize achievements that fulfil the ideals and goals of STARFLEET Medical.



Dr Crusher Award for CPR Training

Awarded automatically to any member of STARFLEET Medical who completes certification in CPR from a certified instructor / Institution (Red Cross, College, Nursing, Medical School, etc.)

Evidence of qualification is needed at time of application.

Issuing Authority: STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Nurse Chapel Award for Basic First Aid Training

Awarded automatically to any member of STARFLEET Medical who completes certification in Basic First Aid (as a minimum) from a certified instructor / Institution (Red Cross, College, Nursing, Medical School, etc.) Evidence of qualification needed at time of application.

Issuing Authority: STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



Counsellor Troi Award for Mental Health First Aid Training

Awarded automatically to any member of STARFLEET Medical who completes certification in Mental Health First Aid Training from a certified instructor / Institution.

Issuing Authority: STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



N.B. All the above awards are valid for as long as the member holds a

current qualification.



CORE Medical Training Program Graduate

Awarded automatically to any member of STARFLEET Medical who completes Levels 1 – 10 of the CORE Medical Training Program. 100 courses in total.

Issuing Authority: STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations



SPECIALIST Medical Training Program Graduate

Awarded automatically to any member of STARFLEET Medical who completes a minimum of 10 medical specialties from the SPECIALIST Medical Training Program. 100 courses in total.

Issuing Authority: STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations

Category III: Staff Awards

These awards recognise service to STARFLEET Medical as well as an individual or group's exemplary actions within STARFLEET Medical.



Surgeon General's Distinguished Service Medal

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who demonstrates **distinguished** service and achievement in keeping with the ideals and tradition of STARLEET Medical.

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Surgeon General Recommendation for this award can be made by the DSG/ Chief of Operations / ASG

Surgeon General's Commendation

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who demonstrates **exemplary** service and achievement in keeping with the ideals and tradition of STARLEET Medical.

Can be awarded as Bronze, Silver or Gold.

Bronze Awards would typically reflect service at the STARFLEET Medical Chapter level. Silver Awards would typically reflect service at the STARFLEET Medical Regional level. Gold Awards would typically reflect service at the STARFLEET Medical Fleet level.

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Surgeon General Recommendation for this award can be made by the DSG/ Chief of Operations / ASG

Letter of Commendation

Awarded to any member of STARFLEET Medical who demonstrates **exceptional** service and achievement in keeping with the ideals and tradition of STARLEET Medical.

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Surgeon General Recommendation for this award can be made by the DSG / Chief of Operations

Starfleet Medical Service Award

Awarded to any member of Starfleet Medical who completes 1 year of service. (Bronze award)

Additional awards are given:

At the completion of 3 years' service (Silver award) At the completion of 5 years' service (Gold award) At 5 year intervals thereafter. (Bars to the gold award)

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations





Dr Phlox Award for Group Effort

Awarded for exemplary group activity and achievement that is in keeping with the goals of STARFLEET Medical.

The activity must demonstrate cooperation between at least two groups, one of which must be STARFLEET Medical on at least the Regional level. This activity should be completed within a calendar year. This award cannot be obtained by individuals.

Issuing Authority: The STARFLEET Medical Chief of Operations Recommendation for work at the Regional level should be made by the relevant ASG

Order of Display

You may choose to display your awards e.g., as part of your Starfleet International email signature.

The order of display is as follows:

- Surgeon General's Distinguished Service Medal
- Surgeon General Commendations (Gold, Silver then Bronze)
- Letter of Commendation
- Starfleet Medical Service Award (most recent)
- Occupation Awards (in the order as displayed in Category I, if more than one)
- Training Awards ((in the order as displayed in Category II)
- Dr Phlox Award

Eligibility

For all STARFLEET Medical awards, nominees must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of STARFLEET, The International Star Trek Fan Association, Inc.
- Be affiliated to STARFLEET Medical on the SFI database https://db.sfi.org/


Application and Nomination

Applications for nominations are equally welcomed from either the member concerned or from others.

For each award, full information must be provided; failure to do so will cause a delay to the issuing of the award.

Unless a delay in awarding is requested, for example to allow for presentation at a chapter or region event, awards will, when approved, be sent directly to the relevant ASG for presentation. They will be announced regionally as well as being announced on the main STARFLEET Medical Facebook Group.
